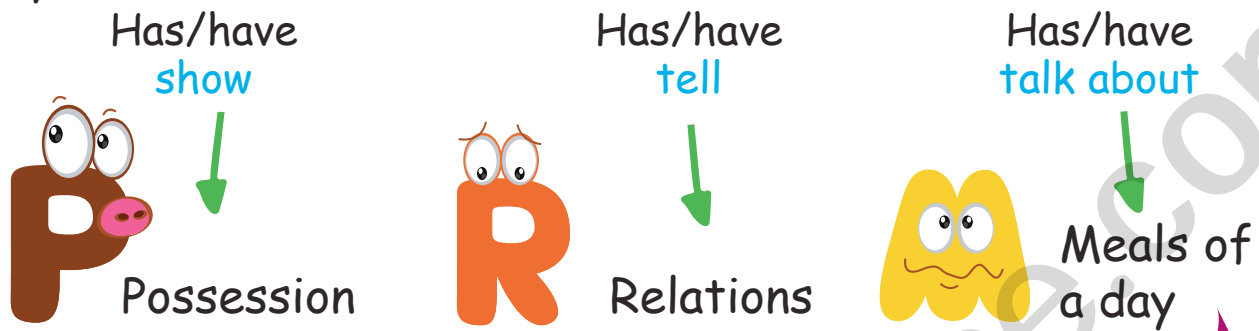

- * Miku **has** a number of **pencils**.



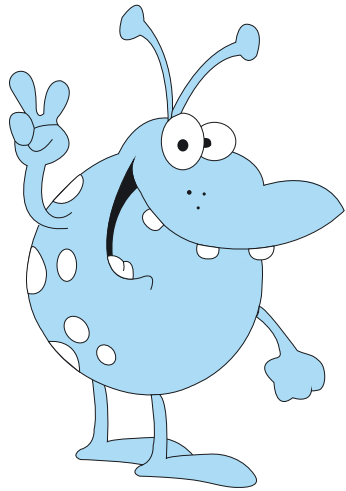
- * I **have** an **elder sister**.
